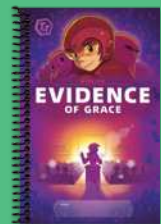
# What is T&T?

Truth and Training™ is the Awana® program for kids in 3rd-6th grade. T&T™ focuses on the basics of the Christian faith and guides kids to a deeper understanding of God's grace. Each year of T&T contains lessons about God (Unit 1), the Bible (Unit 2), Jesus (Unit 3), Life Application (Unit 4), and corresponding memory verses.



## Mission: Grace in Action

Focuses on the core aspects of who God is, what the Bible does, information about Jesus, and an in-depth exploration of grace.



## Mission: Evidence of Grace

Focuses on God's character, the different sections of the Bible, the redemption narrative, and discipleship basics.



## Mission: Agents of Grace

Focuses on the attributes of God, the importance of biblical theology, Jesus' "I Am" statements, and Christian character qualities.



## Mission: Discovery of Grace

Focuses on the attributes of God, why God gave us the Bible, Jesus' death and resurrection, and God's grace in our lives.

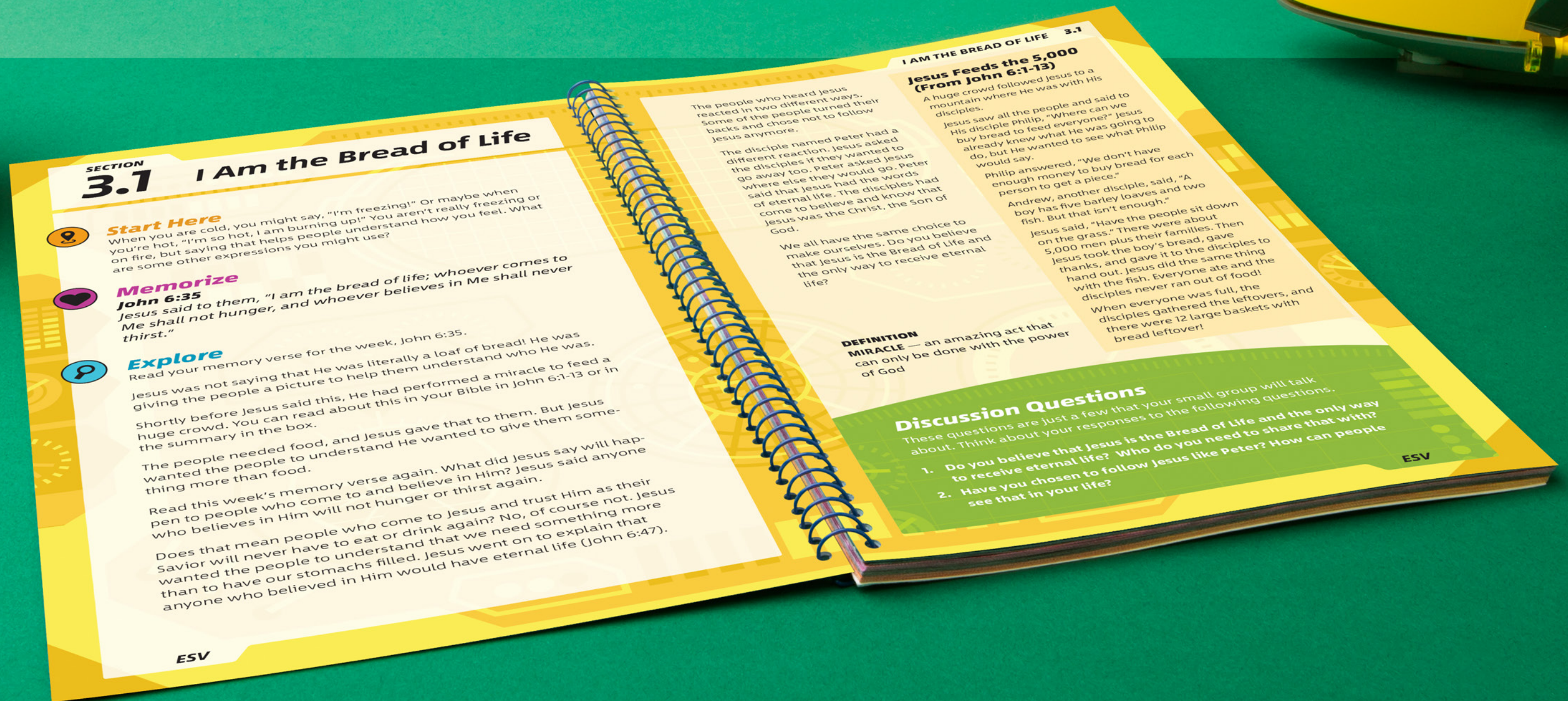

### SECTION 3.1

## I Am the Bread of Life



### Start Here

When you are cold, you might say, "I'm freezing!" Or maybe when you're hot, "I'm so hot, I am burning up!" You aren't really freezing or on fire, but saying that helps people understand how you feel. What are some other expressions you might use?



### Memorize

**John 6:35**

Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to Me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in Me shall never thirst."



### Explore

Read your memory verse for the week, John 6:35.

Jesus was not saying that He was literally a loaf of bread! He was giving the people a picture to help them understand who He was.

Shortly before Jesus said this, He had performed a miracle to feed a huge crowd. You can read about this in your Bible in John 6:1-13 or in the summary in the box.

The people needed food, and Jesus gave that to them. But Jesus wanted the people to understand He wanted to give them something more than food.

Read this week's memory verse again. What did Jesus say will happen to people who come to and believe in Him? Jesus said anyone who believes in Him will not hunger or thirst again.

Does that mean people who come to Jesus and trust Him as their Savior will never have to eat or drink again? No, of course not. Jesus wanted the people to understand that we need something more than to have our stomachs filled. Jesus went on to explain that anyone who believed in Him would have eternal life (John 6:47).

### I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE 3.1

## Jesus Feeds the 5,000 (From John 6:1-13)

A huge crowd followed Jesus to a mountain where He was with His disciples.

Jesus saw all the people and said to His disciple Philip, "Where can we buy bread to feed everyone?" Jesus already knew what He was going to do, but He wanted to see what Philip would say.

Philip answered, "We don't have enough money to buy bread for each person to get a piece."

Andrew, another disciple, said, "A boy has five barley loaves and two fish. But that isn't enough."

Jesus said, "Have the people sit down on the grass." There were about 5,000 men plus their families. Then Jesus took the boy's bread, gave thanks, and gave it to the disciples to hand out. Jesus did the same thing with the fish. Everyone ate and the disciples never ran out of food!

When everyone was full, the disciples gathered the leftovers, and there were 12 large baskets with bread leftover!

### DEFINITION

1. Do you believe that Jesus is the Bread of Life and the only way to receive eternal life? Who do you need to share that with?
2. Have you chosen to follow Jesus like Peter? How can people see that in your life?

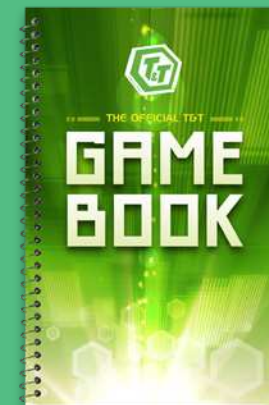

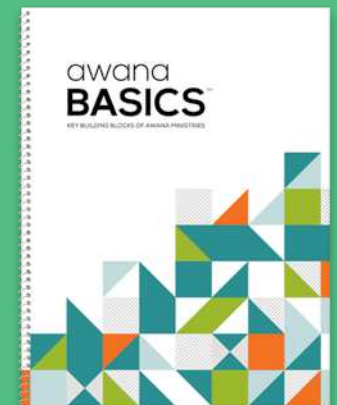
